

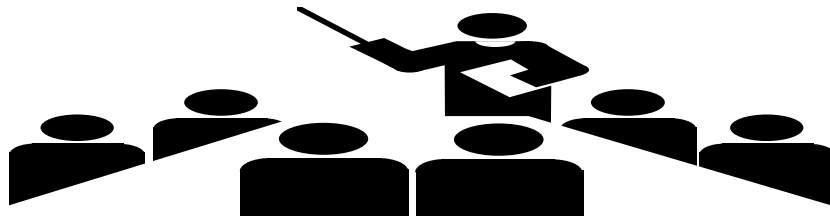

## “EMPOWERED TO EVANGELIZE”

Key Verses: Zechariah 4:6; Acts 1:8

**PROPOSITION:**     **The ministry of the Holy Spirit is the source of dynamic leadership, victorious living, and effective evangelism in the church.**

### **I.     The Holy Spirit empowers us to properly lead God’s people.**

- A.     The Holy Spirit enabled Joseph’s rise to leadership in Egypt. (Genber 41:38-40)
- B.     The Holy Spirit empowered Moses and his 70 Elders to lead. (Number 11:18-30)
- C.     The Holy Spirit equipped Joshua to succeed Moses as leader. (Number 27:12-23)
- D.     The Holy Spirit was the secret of Samson’s strength. (Jude. 13:24, 25; 14:5-14; 15:14-19)
- E.     The Holy Spirit was the secret of King David’s leadership. (1 Samuel 16:7-14)
- F.     The Holy Spirit empowered the great prophets to lead. (2 Kings 2:7)
- G.     The Holy Spirit was the secret of Daniel’s great wisdom. (Daniel 5:10-12)
- H.     The Holy Spirit’s infilling was a requirement for leaders in the church. (Acts 6:1-6)

### **II.    The Holy Spirit empowers us to victoriously keep God’s commandments.**

- A.     The indwelling Holy Spirit enables us to fully follow the Lord. (Numbers 14:24: 32:9-12)
- B.     The indwelling Holy Spirit enables us to obey God’s laws. (Ezekiel 11:19, 20;  
36:25-27)
- C.     The indwelling Holy Spirit enables us to mortify the deeds of the body. (Romans 8:9-14)

### **III.   The Holy Spirit empowers us to effectively proclaim God’s gospel.**

- A.     The Holy Spirit empowered John, the Baptist, to turn people to Christ. (Luke 1:13-17)
- B.     The Holy Spirit empowered the Lord, Jesus, to preach the gospel. (Luke 3:22; 4:18, 19)
- C.     The Holy Spirit empowered the Apostles to preach the gospel. (Acts 1:4-8; 2:1-11)
- D.     The Holy Spirit empowers all believers to proclaim the gospel. (Acts 2:12-21)
  - 1.     Both genders (sons & daughters)
  - 2.     All ages (young men & old men)
  - 3.     All classes of people (menservants & maidservants)
